- Pupils with an improving sense of chronology and who understand differences from the past to the present day.

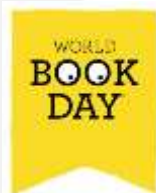


Huge congratulations to Abdulrehman and Usman in class 6A.

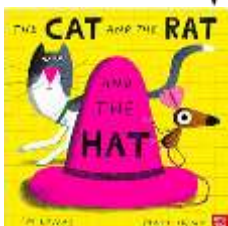
