Re: Partial class closures due to strike action on Wednesday 5th July & Friday 7th July

Dear Parents / Carers,

As previously shared, there is a two-day planned strike for some education staff on **Wednesday 5th July & Friday 7th July**. This has been called by the NEU and is not a decision the school has made.

We have worked hard to make arrangements for as many pupils as possible to be in school on these days, as we understand the significant impact that any school closure has for you, your family and your child(ren).

Please see below for an overview of which classes will be open and which classes will be closed on **Wednesday 5th July & Friday 7th July**. Where a class is open, this may not be with the usual class teacher but will be with familiar staff, who are known to school.

As always, the decision to partially close the school is a serious one and only used as a last resort. The safety and wellbeing of all our pupils is our main priority.

All children will be expected to attend school as normal on non-strike days.
