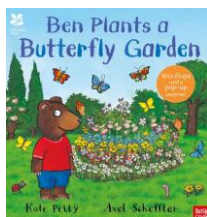

Bring photo ID to vote in the Local Elections and GMCA Mayoral Election TODAY!!!

On Thursday 2 May 2024, local elections and the Greater Manchester Combined Authority Mayoral Election will take place across Greater Manchester.

A wide range of photo ID will be accepted, including passports, driving licences, and cards with a PASS Mark.

If you do not have an accepted photo ID then you can apply for a free Voter Authority Certificate, but you must apply before the deadline of 5pm of 24 April 2024.
